### **Parking Location and Instructions**

Participants can park at the 9-Scotia Plaza parking lot, 12700 W. Nine Mile Rd. (at the northwest corner of West Nine Mile and Scotia). Please park in the far southeast corner of the parking lot (farthest from the building).

Gather at Connector Park (one block east of the 9-Scotia Plaza parking lot). Oak Park's leadership will welcome participants and give an overview of the Nine Mile Redesign Project.

Explore the Nine Mile Linear Park from Scotia Rd. to Rosewood Ave. Visit Seneca Pocket Park and meet the new business owners at Ines & Marie. Engage with the Oak Park artist behind the "Earth Girl" and "Hoops Guy" sculptures.

Meet the apartment owners and learn about this new transit-oriented development.

## 4:45 p.m. - 5:15 p.m. | Sherman Pocket Park, Pie Sci Pizza, and Hansen's Hall

Connect with the new owners of Pie Sci Pizza and Hansen's Hall. Hansen's Hall is the first neighborhood bar in the city, set to open soon. City buses will transport the participants back to the parking lot of 9-Scotia Plaza. Participants are invited to drive to Oak Park's Social District at Mother Handsome, 14661 W. Eleven Mile Rd.
