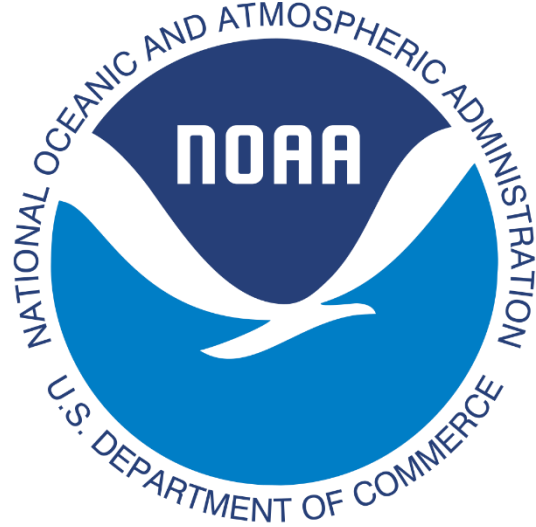

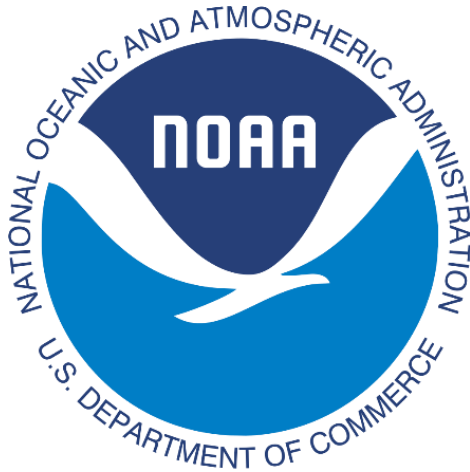

# Michigan Coastal Management Program

Michigan Coastal Management Program established in 1978

A state-federal partnership with the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration

Federal-state-local partnership structure

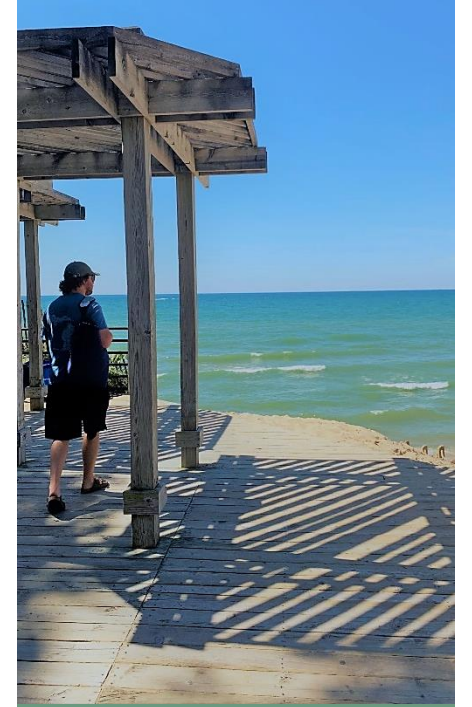

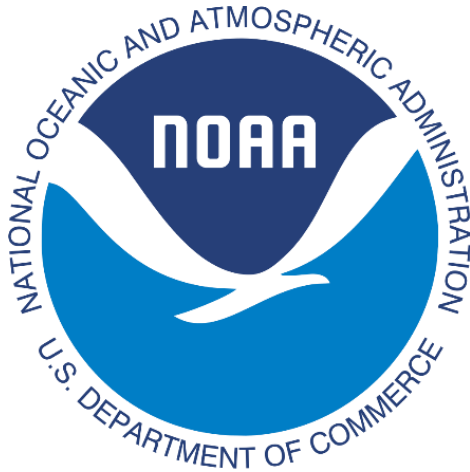


